Hollywood Private Hospital

First ever WA lung cancer patient to receive new treatment.

A global phase 2 clinical trial is investigating whether tumor infiltrating lymphocytes (TIL) is safe and effective for different types of patients with Metastatic Non-Small Cell Lung Cancer (NSCLC).

Hollywood Private Hospital has recruited and is dosing the first ever lung cancer patient in WA with this new treatment.

So how does it actually work?

A small piece of the patients tumour is removed, and immune cells (TIL's) from the tumour are grown and activated in a lab. The patient then receives a short course of chemotherapy to prepare the body, before the lab-grown TIL's are infused back into the patient.

A medication called IL-2 is then given to the patient to help the TIL's work better with the goal of shrinking or controlling the lung cancer.



North Shore Private Hospital cardiologist, Dr Karan Rao has been awarded the prestigious Ralph Reader Prize for his work in patients undergoing transcatheter aortic valve implantation (TAVI). Dr Rao was one of three finalists who presented their work at the CSANZ Annual Scientific Meeting. Dr Ravi Bhindi (pictured), is Dr Rao's PhD supervisor and attended the CSANZ ASM as well.

CONDUCT-TAVI is an observational study of 200 patients undergoing transcatheter aortic valve implantation (TAVI) across two centres. This piece of Dr Rao's PhD aims to predict the incidence of permanent pacemaker implantation (PPMI) due to high grade atrioventricular block (HGAVB) after TAVI.
